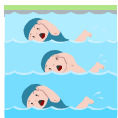

By doing so we are keeping our school safe and demonstrating our pride.

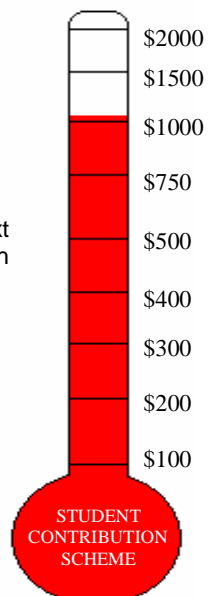
If the students can stop me from finding 20 pieces of rubbish after our next emu parade then each class will get a group reward (as chosen by each class).

A pair of children's blue reading glasses have been found. If these belong to you, they can be collected from the office.



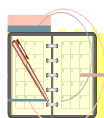

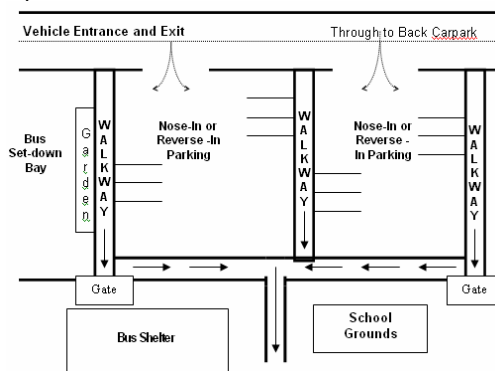
If your child is attending either of these camps, please pay at the office ASAP. Attendance at camp will not be permitted if payment has not been received.
