We have however been able to work through all of these issues and the students have handled the whole situation easily in their stride.

Record how many books your child has read on the enclosed reader record form and return to their teacher by 27 August. Every student who completes the challenge will receive a Certificate of Achievement signed by the Premier.

To complete the challenge:

- Prep to Year 2 must read or experience at least 20 books,
- Years 3 and 4 must read at least 20 books, and
- Years 5 to 9 must read at least 15 books.

Experiencing books can include shared reading, listening to stories, or reading picture books. The aim for the 2021 challenge is to engage more students to read than ever before.
