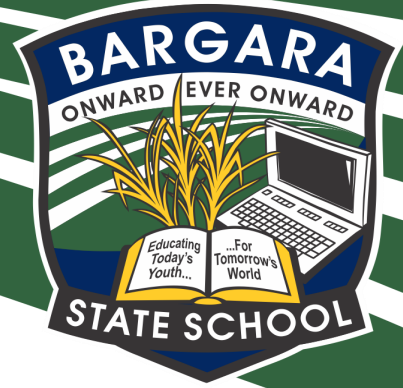

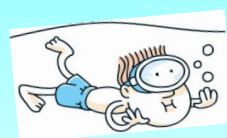
Required: Togs, towel and a pair of thongs, a sturdy bag (not a plastic shopping bag as these tear easily and items are lost.)
