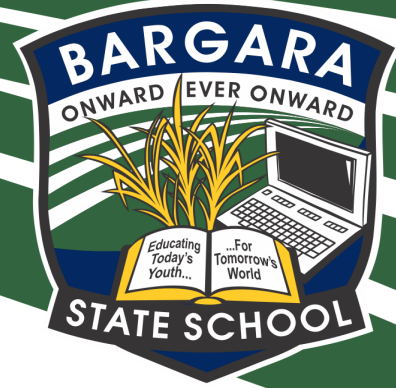

Student Awards

This year at our Special Awards Parade on Monday we will be presenting a series of awards for students. These awards are designed to recognise those students who may not necessarily receive a special award such as 'Dux' but who have achieved a high level of academic achievement or displayed a real 'Commitment to Learning.'

The 'Commitment to Learning' awards will be awarded to students in all year levels who have been judged to meet certain criteria. These criteria include behaviour (in all areas), attendance, uniform pride, completing work, effort across all subjects and general organisation. The 'Commitment to Learning' awards will be awarded at two levels – Commendation and Excellence. In Years 4-6, we will also acknowledge academic excellence across 3 levels (Bronze, Silver and Gold) depending on a student's academic results in Semester 2.

Students receiving one of these awards will have brought home an invitation to the parade on Wednesday. Please check the bottom of your child's bag.

Unfortunately, due to restrictions, we are only able to invite one family member to attend these events.

Report Cards

Reports cards are planned to be sent home on Tuesday with the students. They will be in a sealed envelope and we encourage students to open these at home. Please talk to your children about how you would like them to handle the report card.

Mrs Roberts and I will read through each report card and we do occasionally pick up a typing error, however I am sure we also miss an occasional one as well. If you do see an error please contact the office where the report will be corrected and reprinted.

Hello families,

If you have already booked in for Vacation Care or if you intend on booking in, this would be a great read for you.

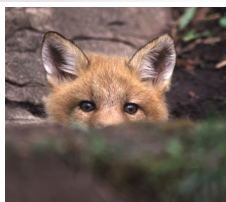

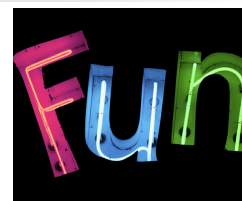
