Carpark Upgrade

Earlier this year, I met with Councillor Greg Barnes who has advocated on our behalf to support this upgrade. You will have noticed the main school car park closure today as the resurfacing process was started. On Saturday this weekend, the main school carpark will be resurfaced and temporary carpark markings applied. It won't be permanently line marked until the school holidays as the council need the resurfacing to 'set' for as long as it can before permanent line marking occurs.

The clothing will be removed during the lesson so we please ask that parents please make sure all items are named.




P&CEaster Raffle
